

Quality Standards- Special Assistance

Our Customers are provided with the following services;

- Assistance and arrangements necessary to communicate their arrival at the Airport and their request for assistance at the designated points inside and outside of the terminal building
- Assistance from the point of set down at the Airport to the check in desk
- Assistance with check in and baggage registration
- Assistance from check in to the boarding gate, including with the Immigration, customs and security procedures
- Assistance in proceeding from the boarding gate to the aircraft and with boarding and disembarking, including the provision of a suitable service for passengers who require special access to/ from the aircraft
- Assistance from the aircraft door to their seat and from their seat to the aircraft door.
- Assistance in the storage and retrieval of hand baggage on the aircraft
- Assistance with proceeding from the aircraft to the baggage hall and retrieval of baggage, including completion of the immigration and customs procedures.
- Assistance with proceeding from the baggage hall to the first point of onward travel.
- Assistance from / to connecting flights both landside and airside
- Assistance to move to the toilet facilities if required.
- Enable the customer to use the Airport facilities as requested, subject to sufficient time.
- Provide a wheelchair only service (non assisted) as requested by customers
- Adequate assistance in the event of delays or cancellation of flights
- Where a Customer is assisted by an accompanying person, this person, is, if requested, allowed
 to provide the necessary assistance in the Airport and with embarking/ disembarking.
- Ground handling of all necessary mobility equipment, including equipment such as electric
 wheelchairs (subject to 48 hours notice and to possible limitations of space on board the aircraft,
 and subject to application of relevant legislation concerning dangerous goods);
- Provide temporary replacement for damaged or lost mobility equipment, recognising this may not be on a like for like basis.



Quality Standards- Special Assistance

- Ground handling of recognised assistance dogs, in line with the Pet Travel Scheme
- Communication of information needed to take flights in accessible formats.
